	Revised sale date for Airfield (2031) The recent promotional flyer distributed to Colerne residents from Cllr Sheila Parker titled 'Colerne Airfield Update' was discussed. The flyer reads: 'The MoD has stated that they will not sell the airfield before 2031', 'Wiltshire Council and Mod will be working on a Masterplanavailable in 2019.' The MoD Document 'A better Defence Estate' shows the following disposal dates; Azimghur Barracks 2031. RAF Colerne Airfield 2018 (Note that this was changed to 2031 at the meeting).'	
	It is thought that the meeting referred to is a regular meeting between Defence Estates and WCC in which multiple estates are discussed, not only those in the Colerne Parish.	
	It was agreed that Jane Melllett write to Sheila Parker as our Counselor. The letter should contain following points:	JM (ASAP)
	 Request for confirmation and authentication of date of airfield sale because of the work the Neighbourhood Plan seeks to do. In the event that Sheila parker cannot give us authentification herself, request the name and contact details of those responsible who can. 	
	The subject of a the Masterplan referred to was discussed and concerns were raised that there may be insufficient public consultation in the process. Questions were raised on why a 2019 masterplan is necessary if the site is not to be sold until 2031. Suggestions were that a masterplan would be needed for a long term leasing of the site which would result in a change of use. It was agreed that we as the CNPSG should be participants and partners in the Masterplan process.	
	Gary Brain advised that the Corsham Masterplan started when the Corsham Neighbourhood Plan was in it's infancy. The Masterplan does not have the weight of the Neighbourhood Plan; we need to be ahead of the Masterplan.
